

Summer Reading Incoming Fourth Graders

The following suggestions are made to serve as a guideline for parents in the selection of children's summer reading. Try to choose books based on your child's lexile range from third grade. We hope that you browse libraries and bookstore shelves and enjoy reading all summer long. A librarian will be able to tell you and your child what the lexile is for a book. Or you can use this link to help you figure out the lexile:

Looking ahead to the fourth grade curriculum, you may also wish to select non-fiction books about the thirteen colonies, U.S. Constitution, Declaration of Independence, and the state of Arizona. Other topics could include the biographies of George Washington, Abraham Lincoln, Paul Revere, or Ben Franklin. You could explore scientific books on weather, animals, or electricity. Folk tales, fairy tales and poetry would be terrific selections as well.

Incoming Fourth Grade Requirements:

1. Choose **TWO books** from the list below. (If you know your lexile range, please choose the books in your range. If you do not know your lexile range choose any two books from the list.)
2. Students will be required to take an SRC test the first week of school on these two books.
3. Read all kinds of books that interest you. Keep a list of the titles and authors of all the books you read over the summer. Bring your list on the first day of school (this will be collected). (Books on THIS LIST do not have to be from the list below.)
