

Incoming Third Graders Summer Reading List

1. You must read, Freckle Juice by Judy Blume. When you have finished the book, prepare the following book report to bring in on the **FIRST** day of school.

- Your name, the title (Freckle Juice), and author (Judy Blume) on the top.
- Write a 2-paragraph summary of the book.
- Write an **additional** paragraph to explain why you did or did not like the book.
- Draw a picture of your favorite part from the book.

2. Choose at least ONE book (not an entire series) from the following list of books to read in addition to the book above. **Make a list** of all the books you read and bring the list on the **FIRST** day of school.
