

Fifth grade supply list

- 1 box colored pencils
- 1 box of crayons (Crayola 24 preferred)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 2 red ball point pens
- 5 blue or black ball point pens
- Pencils (prefer mechanical)
- Small pencil sharpener
- 12 inch ruler with centimeters included
- 1 simple protractor (half moon shape not the swivel kind)
- 1 pencil box or bag large enough to hold the supplies above
- 2 Glue sticks or a bottle of white glue
- 3 pkgs. Loose leaf paper (wide rule)
- 1 package of graph paper (1/4 inch)
- 1 package assorted colors construction paper
- 1 bottle of Hand Sanitizer (non-scented please)
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 2 canisters of Clorox wipes
- 2 boxes of facial tissues
- 1 book bag/backpack
- Pocket folders as needed for each subject below are required
 - 1 specially designated for correspondence (homework and etc)
 - 2 red folders for Scholastic Reading Counts
 - 4 composition books-Religion, Social Studies, English, Literature
 - 3 notebooks for other subjects
 - Spanish/English dictionary

- 12 1 box Kleenex tissues (generic – ok)
- 13 8th Grade: 1 Spiral bound sketchbook
